## Elders Discipleship Group 14

**Purpose of the Elders Discipleship Group:** To Train and Equip Discipleship Group leaders to lead more effectively.

**Key Theme:** Vision

**Key Truth:** We are to speak and write down what we see and share this with God's people.

*Revelation 1:10-11 I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and I heard behind me a loud voice like the sound of a trumpet, saying, "Write in a book what you see, and send it to the seven churches: to Ephesus and to Smyrna and to Pergamum and to Thyatira and to Sardis and to Philadelphia and to Laodicea."*

*Revelation 1:19 Therefore write the things which you have seen, and the things which are, and the things which will take place after these things.*

**Read:** John wrote down in the book of Revelation all that God showed him, so the church could be aware of the things that are and what is to come. We are to be a ready people, a prepared people, a people made complete, because of everything we can see and receive and know from the realm of the Spirit

He saw in the Spirit and captured what he was shown by God in this book. The book of Revelation, for many, is seen as a book that can't be known or understood, and this is far from the truth. The book of Revelation is about the revelation of Jesus Christ and everything contained in Christ. We have been granted to know all the mysteries of God's kingdom and we are to be stewards of these mysteries.

God gave each church a report on what He saw. He gave an accurate description of the things they were in and the things that were not of Him and areas they needed to repent of. There are 7 promises given to all those who overcome the world, the flesh and the adversary. Here are the promises listed:

1. I will grant to eat of the tree of life which is in the Paradise of God.
2. I will give the crown of life.
3. I will give him a white stone and a new name written on the stone.
4. I will give him authority over the nations and he shall rule them with a rod of iron.
5. I will not erase his name from the book of life and I will confess his name before My Father.
6. I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God.
7. I will grant him to sit down with me on My throne.

These are the future now promises for all those who truly overcome by the power of the spirit and truth. This is the inheritance for the church to come into now. Every promise is Yes and Amen in God and we know that God is not a liar and He is unchangeable. John said it's our faith that overcomes the world. It's the ability to see and know what is in God for us and to receive all of these promises in our hearts and minds. We are to be living from this new reality of truth in us, that enables us to be overcomers, rather than be a people who are overcome by the world, the flesh and the adversary.
