Theme: Not yet knowing as one ought to know.

Key Truth: Being prepared to earnestly seek, what one doesn't currently have knowledge of.

Key Scripture: Hebrews 11:6

We can see in the introduction that there are a number of tensions and challenges in relation to Greg's knowledge and understanding in certain areas of God's truth. Greg is asked to consider a reality he has no reference for and he is also asked to consider walking with his brother to discover if this reference is of God or not.

Greg acknowledges he received way more than what he bargained for and still is and urges us all to go on this journey with the Spirit.

Questions:

- 1. Discuss as a group what earnestly seeking God looks like?
- 2. How hungry and thirsty are we for a spiritual reality we do not yet know of?
- 3. Why is it the glory of God to conceal a matter Proverbs 25:2?
- 4. What do you think it is that makes some hungry and thirsty for what's concealed and others not?
- 5. What are the blessings we can know from discovering these hidden promises?

Action point: What are you being made aware of through this resource and is there one thing you need to put in place after going through this resource?
