Elders Discipleship Group 9

Purpose of the Elders Discipleship Group: To Train and Equip Discipleship Group leaders to lead more effectively.

Key Theme: Vision

Key Truth: Recap the 8 truths shared so far.

Read: This week's resource is about recapping the previous 8 key truths and discussing them. It is essential we constantly remember what is being shared as what is being shared are precepts, key truths, which our lives are to be being built upon. To not be being built on what is being spoken is to not be hearing the Word and being built, so we need to constantly be evaluating where we are at in our transformational process.

We are built on our ability, in the spirit, to hear the Word of God. We can have great discussion and dialogue but not hear the Word that builds us.

Remember the purpose of discipleship is to conformed into Christ likeness. Christ like people hear, see, speak and live like Christ did. They have Christ's eternal life of the spirit being built and formed within them, so the attitudes of being, the beatitudes become their new nature.

The 8 truths so far are:

1. Vision in the Kingdom of God is Sight. It's seeing as God sees.
2. We are to see the unseen realm
3. Raised us up with Him and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus
4. Work for food which endures to eternal life
5. God or the spirit, is the one who opens our eyes to have vision
6. Sight empowers Christlike living
7. Vision manifests the future in our present
8. Walking in alignment to have our spiritual eyes opened
