

IDENTITY - BOND SERVANTS PART 3 (SECOND LANGUAGE)

Revelation 22:3-4 There will no longer be any curse; and the throne of God and of the Lamb will be in it, and His bond-servants will serve Him; they will see His face, and His name will be on their foreheads.

Or in other words;

Revelation 22:3-4 There will not be any curse. The throne of God, which is the Lamb's throne, will be in the city. God's bond servants will serve him. They will see his face. His name will be on their foreheads (the front of their head).

There are three promises in these verses. The promises are for everyone who is a bond servant of God. These promises are why it is so important that we become bond servants of Christ. This is why we should live the life of a bond servant now. We must only focus on the life we live now. This is to honour the Father by doing His will (what He wants).

This truth is based in the New Jerusalem. The New Jerusalem (the city of God) is the place where we can be with God forever. This is the reward for everyone who lives as a bond servant. A bond servant overcomes the demonic (anything influenced by demons), the world and the flesh (self).

Here is the reward for those who live their lives on earth as bond servants (or bond slaves) for Christ.

- 1. They will serve the Father.
- 2. They will see the Father's face.
- 3. The Father's name will be on their foreheads.

It is clear that people who are bond servants of Christ will not get the mark of the beast. This is because the mark of the beast is put on the hand or forehead. Bond servants of Jesus Christ have Christ as their Lord. They have the Great Commandment written on their hearts and hands and forehead. It is also written on their door posts and gates long before everyone goes through the greatest test.

This living reality (truth) protects the bond servant. They will not get the mark of the beast in the last days.

This is an amazing reward for the bond servant of Christ. The bond servant will serve the Father and see his face. It says in the Bible that no one can see the face of God and live. Yet the bond servant can look God straight in His eyes of love. The bond servant has the name of God written on their forehead as Revelation 22:4 and Revelation 3:12 say.

Revelation 3:12 He who overcomes, I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God, and he will not go out from it anymore; and I will write on him the name of My God, and the name of the city of My God, the new Jerusalem, which comes down out of heaven from My God, and My new name.

Or in other words;

Revelation 3:12 Everyone who overcomes will be safe in God's house. I will make them like a strong pillar in God's Temple (Great House). They will never leave God's house again. I will write on them the name of my God and the name of His city. The name of that city is New Jerusalem. That city will come down from heaven. My God will send it down to the earth. I will also write My new name on those people.
